Since October 2000, Second Chance Fund for Animal Welfare has spayed/neutered over 8,000 animals, including many homeless cats - either feral or abandoned pets. According to the MSPCA survey results published in 2006, 6% of all pet cats are not spayed or neutered. This appears to be a relatively small number, only 6,000 in Worcester County, MA. But once lost or abandoned, these 6% in the home become 66% of all homeless street cats or 50,000-150,000 cats! They breed like crazy for several years before the stress and peril of homelessness sadly overcomes them.

Therefore we focus on spaying and neutering as many pet cats as possible to curtail homelessness before it starts. *We believe this is the most effective way to end the suffering, by addressing the root cause.*

QUICK FIX CLINIC PROGRAM NEEDS VOLUNTEERS!!!

Our affordable spay/neuter program, known as "Quick Fix Clinics", is always in need of volunteers. Please consider helping us! (* indicates a task that can be done from your home):

HANDS-ON CLINIC TEAMS of 2-3 volunteers are needed at each clinic to usher participants in, check names off our confirmation list, and cash them out.

*HOTLINE MESSAGE RETRIEVERS** retrieve sign-up calls from clients on our hotline and email the information to volunteers who make the calls to sign up participants.

*CALL BACK AND SCHEDULERS** return calls from messages left on the hotline and schedule participants into available clinic slots.

*CONFIRMATION MAILERS AND REMINDER CALLERS** send out confirmation notifications and make reminder calls to clinic participants.
